

Planning and Advanced Reservation of Capacity Agreement (PARCA)

NOTICE: CLOSURE OF A PARCA EXIT WINDOW

Friday, 26th May 2017

Dear Industry Colleague,

In accordance with Uniform Network Code, Transportation Principal Document, Section B, paragraph 1.16, National Grid Gas Transmission hereby publishes this notice to all interested industry parties that the PARCA Exit Window, opened on Monday, 27th March 2017, has now closed.

National Grid has received two further PARCA Applications during this PARCA Exit Window.

Application 1

- The geographical area of the project is North East Yorkshire and Lincolnshire (Region 3 as defined in the [Gas Ten Year Statement](#)).
- The indicative range of the NTS exit capacity applied for is 32,000,000kWh/d – 102,300,000kWh/d.
- The indicative capacity reservation date is 30th November 2017.
- The indicative capacity registration date is 1st October 2020 to 1st October 2022.

Application 2

- The geographical area of the project is North East Yorkshire and Lincolnshire (Region 3 as defined in the [Gas Ten Year Statement](#)).
- The indicative range of the NTS exit capacity applied for is 58,241,267kWh/d – 71,183,770kWh/d.
- The indicative capacity reservation date is 30th November 2017.
- The indicative capacity registration date is 30th November 2020.
