

Planning and Advanced Reservation of Capacity (PARCA)

NOTICE: OPENING OF A PARCA EXIT WINDOW

6th November, 2018

Dear Industry Colleague,

In accordance with the Uniform Network Code, Section B, National Grid hereby publishes this notice to all interested industry parties that a PARCA Exit Window will be opened tomorrow Wednesday, 7th November 2018. The PARCA Exit Window provides an opportunity for those parties who are interested in applying for a PARCA to submit their applications during this time so that we can consider those applications alongside other potential projects.

The applications received so far are as follows;

Application 1

- The geographical area of the project is Scotland and the North (Region 1 in the Gas Ten Year Statement¹). This region is North of Longtown and Bishop Auckland, and comprises NTS/DN exit zones SC1, 2, 3, & 4, NO1 & 2.
- The amount of NTS exit capacity applied for 2,808,000kWh/d.
- The indicative capacity reservation date is 3rd May, 2019.
- The indicative capacity registration date is 1st April, 2020.

Application 2

- The geographical area of the project is Norfolk (Region 7 in the Gas Ten Year Statement). This region is North of Diss and Cambridge, and comprises NTS/DN exit zones EA1, 2, 3.
- The amount of NTS exit capacity applied for is between 48,258,065kWh/d & 72,387,097kWh/d.
- The indicative capacity reservation date is 3rd May, 2019.
- The indicative capacity registration date is 1st April, 2022.

The PARCA Exit Window will be opened for a maximum of 40 consecutive business days from 7th November 2018, closing on 7th January 2019. If no further PARCA Applications are received within 20 consecutive business days, the window will be closed on 4th December 2018.
