

## **Planning and Advanced Reservation of Capacity (PARCA)**

### **NOTICE: OPENING OF A PARCA EXIT WINDOW**

**24<sup>th</sup> October, 2016**

Dear all, In accordance with the UNC Modification 0465V, National Grid hereby publishes this notice to all interested industry parties following the receipt of a technically competent PARCA Application, that a PARCA Exit Window will be opened on 25<sup>th</sup> October, 2016 to enable those parties who are interested in applying for a PARCA to submit their applications during this time.

Application summary:-

The geographical area of the project is London, Suffolk & the South East (Region 9 in the [2015 Gas Ten Year Statement](#))

The amount of NTS exit capacity applied for is 16,880,983 kW/d rising to 28,193,017 kWh/d

The indicative capacity reservation date is 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2017

The indicative capacity registration date is 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2019

The PARCA Exit Window will be opened for a maximum of 40 consecutive business days from the 25<sup>th</sup> October, 2016, closing on the 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2016. If in the event that no further PARCA Applications are received within 20 consecutive business days the window will be closed.
