

Planning and Advanced Reservation of Capacity (PARCA)

NOTICE: OPENING OF A PARCA WINDOW

1st October 2015

Dear all,

In accordance with the UNC Modification 0465V, National Grid hereby publishes this notice to all interested industry parties following the receipt of a technically competent PARCA Application, that a PARCA window will be opened on the 1st October 2015 to enable those parties who are interested in applying for a PARCA to submit their applications during this time.

Application summary:-

The geographical area of the project is Scotland & the North (Region 1 as defined in GTYS)

The indicative range of the NTS exit capacity applied for is 4,848,000 kW/d – 6,264,000 kWh/d

The indicative capacity reservation date is April 2016

The indicative capacity registration date is January 2018

The PARCA window will be opened for a maximum of 40 consecutive business days from the 1st October 2015, closing on the 25th November 2015, but if in the event after 20 consecutive business days no further PARCA applications have been received, the window will be closed.
