Connection Charging Statement – Annual Review

- Standard Condition 4B of National Grid's Gas Transporter Licence requires us to conduct a review of NTS Connection Charges at least once per year.
- The last review was carried out in late 2020 and the revised Connection Charging Statement published on 17th January 2021.
- The proposed scope of this year's review is explained in this presentation as well as the expected timeline.

Connection Charging Statement Annual Review – Proposed Scope

- **PARCA/CAM Application Fees**
 - Annual review to identify any required changes
- **Current A20 Application Fees**
 - Annual review to identify any required changes
- **Other updates**
 - Self Lay - Following commissioning of the pilot project, a new fee is being considered for Self Lay applications where a Self Lay organisation is to carry out the works on behalf of the customer, rather than National Grid being responsible for the works.
 - Indicative Connection Charges and Examples – includes potential costs savings with regards to Remotely Operable Valves / Remote Telemetry Units, and 4G installations.
 - Formatting and consistency changes.
