Planning and Advanced Reservation of Capacity (PARCA)

NOTICE: PARCA EXIT WINDOW UPDATE

Dear Industry Colleague,

On 28 June 2024 we published a notice following the receipt of a Competent PARCA Application. A PARCA Exit Window was opened on 01 July 2024 to enable those parties interested in applying for a PARCA to also submit their applications. We have received one further PARCA Application which is technically competent, as follows;

Application 1

- The geographical area of the application is the North-East, Yorkshire and Lincolnshire (Region 3 as defined in Gas Ten Year Statement¹). This region is South of Bishop Auckland, north of Peterborough and Wisbech and east of Nether Kellet.
- The quantity of the NTS exit capacity applied for is between **14,890,510**kWh/d and **38,540,145**kWh/d.
- The indicative capacity reservation date is **01 February 2025**.
- The indicative capacity Registration Date is **01 January 2028 01 October 2030**

The PARCA Exit Window will remain open for the maximum of 40 consecutive business days closing on **23** August 2024.
