

How to Obtain the NTS Transportation Model

Introduction

The Transportation Model has been developed by National Grid to seek to enable transparency of its Gas Charging Methodology in respect of the GB National Transmission System (NTS), and is provided on this understanding.

While the model is available free of charge, it is provided under licence to restrict, among other things, its distribution and commercial use. Users wishing to obtain the licence are asked to return a hard copy of the licence agreement, signed on behalf of their organisation by post to our Charging and Capacity Development Team at the address below.

Once the signed licence agreement has been received, we will e-mail a copy of the Transportation Model spreadsheet and some guidance notes. Please note that National Grid does not provide specific training for the software, but we will be happy to answer your questions regarding use of the model. Please also note that the model is provided solely for the purposes of estimating capacity charges in respect of the NTS, and is not intended for any other purpose.

Operating Environment

The model has been developed using Microsoft Office Excel 2010 and tested on National Grid's company operating system (based on Windows 7), and is expected to perform as described below on similar Microsoft Windows based systems such as Windows XP. However, National Grid cannot guarantee the correct behaviour of the model when operated on other systems.

Before using the model, users are asked to satisfy themselves that they are able to comply with the terms of the NTS Charging Model Software Licence Agreement that sets out the terms on which National Grid provide this software.
