

QUOTATION CHARGE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. In consideration for the Customer providing the necessary information as defined in our National Grids Connections Business Rules¹ and paying the Quotation Charge as set out in National Grid's Gas Distribution Connection Service Charges², published from time to time on the internet. National Grid will prepare and issue a quotation to meet the Customer's requested requirements to either supply a new gas service connection or an alteration to an existing service connection.
- 2. National Grid will provide a quotation within the time scales set out on National Grid's Connections Business Rule
- 3. In the event that National Grid does not provide a quotation within the time scales specified above or that the quotation is inaccurate then any liability to the Customer arising from the delay or inaccuracy as the case may be will be capped at either the level of compensation provided for in any statutory rulers applying from time to time or the amount of the Quotation Charge paid by the customer, whichever is the lesser.
- 4. No provision of this agreement shall or may be construed as creating any rights enforceable by a third party (whether under the Contracts Act or otherwise) and all third party rights as may be implied by law (whether under the Contracts Act or otherwise) are hereby excluded to the fullest extent permitted by law from any Contract.
- 5. This agreement is governed by the laws of England and subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts where the Works are carried out in England or Wales, and the exclusive jurisdiction of the Scottish Courts where the Works are carried out in Scotland.
