Stage One Results

National Grid LNG Storage has today announced the results of Stage One of its Annual Storage Invitation, held on 1st April 2011.

A total of 386.25 GWh (13.2 million therms) of space were sold.

The auction saw significant interest from shippers at Avonmouth with demand being greater than the amount of capacity offered.

The average price of accepted bids across the three facilities was 0.455 p/kWh (13.3 p/therm). There were 5 bidders in the auction all of which were successful.

The Stage Two auction, in which a further 128.75 GWh (4.4 million therms) of space will be made available, is scheduled to take place on Wednesday 6th April. Applications for capacity must be received by 12.00hrs. The results for Stage Two will be announced by 10.00hrs on Thursday 7th April.
