Stage One Results

National Grid LNG Storage has today announced the results of stage one of its Annual Storage Invitation, held on 2nd April 2013.

A total of 237.6 GWh (8.11 million therms) of space and 9 tankering slots were sold.

The auction saw significant interest from shippers at Avonmouth with demand being greater than the amount of capacity offered.

The average price of accepted bids was 0.5250 p/kWh (15.39 p/therm). There were five bidders in the auction, four of which were successful.

The stage two auction, in which a further 158.4 GWh (5.40 million therms) of space and 3 remaining tanker slots will be made available, is scheduled to take place on Tuesday 9th April. Applications for capacity must be received by 12.00hrs. The results for stage two will be announced by 10.00hrs on Friday 12th April.
