## **Stage Two Results**

National Grid LNG Storage has today announced the results of Stage Two of its 2014 Annual Storage Invitation held on 8<sup>th</sup> April 2014.

A total of 150.0 GWh (5.118 million therms) of space was sold. The auction saw significant interest from shippers at Avonmouth with demand being greater than capacity offered.

The average price of accepted bids was 0.6747p/kWh (19.77p/therm). There were five bidders in the auction, all successful.

The total results of Stage One and Two mean that a total of 300GWh (10.24 million therms) of space has been sold in the 2014 Annual Storage Invitation at an average price of 0.6545 p/kWh (19.18 p/therm).

Two tanker slots remain unallocated at Avonmouth. These slots can be purchased on a first come first served basis at a price of £9413.94 per annum.
