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Avonmouth Facility

NG LNG Storage has previously engaged market participants seeking long term commercial contracts to underpin reinvestment in its facilities

- Clear market signal no requirement given diversity in supplies and demand side markets.
- Conversion of Isle of Grain, Sale and Closure Dynevor, Glenmavis, Partington

Lack of operational resilience and repeated failures of the aging process plant at Avonmouth. (30+ years old)

- 7 unplanned outages in last 7 years
- Last 2 years liquefaction failure has occurred with extended lead-times necessary for repair impacting LNG stock replenishment and strategic spare provisions.

NG LNG Storage have reminded stakeholders of the resilience risks of the plant and single point of failure

- NGG Operating Margins already implemented contestable supply / demand side contracts
- Discussions ongoing with SGN with regard to the Statutory Independent Undertakings.
- LNG retailers already importing from NW European terminals
