Consultation on "The Entry Capacity Transfer and Trade Methodology Statement": Notification of Revised Consultation Close-out Date.

On 19th December 2007 National Grid NTS initiated a consultation on its proposed revised Transfer and Trade Methodology Statement. The deadline for receipt of responses to the consultation was 17:00 on 17th January 2008.

National Grid NTS has put forward a UNC modification proposal to facilitate the Transfer and Trade of Entry Capacity. In setting the deadline for responses to the consultation on the Methodology Statement it was intended that the methodology statement and the UNC modification proposal could be reviewed in parallel.
