NOTICE: PARCA APPLICATION – (NTS Region – Scotland and the North)

UPDATE

Dear Industry Colleague,

In accordance with Uniform Network Code (“UNC”) Modification 0465V, National Grid hereby publishes this notice to all interested parties.

On the 25th November 2015 National Grid issued a notice, with respect to a competent Planning & Advanced Reservation of Capacity Agreement (“PARCA”) application. The PARCA application was for National Transmission System (“NTS”) exit capacity between 4,848,000 kWh/d and 6,264,000 kWh/d in Scotland & the North, Region 1 of the NTS. The indicative capacity reservation date specified at the time was April 2016, with the indicative capacity registration date of January 2018.

Today, 17th June 2016 National Grid is issuing this notice to confirm the PARCA Application has now progressed to Phase 2 of the PARCA process and 6,264,000 kWh/d of system exit capacity has been reserved through non obligated capacity for the period January 2018 to September 2019 and substituted capacity from October 2019 onwards.

7,041,395 kWh/d of system exit capacity has been reserved for substitution at the donor exit point (Glenmavis Offtake) for the purposes of the exit capacity substitution highlighted above.
