The Statement and Methodology of the Gas Transmission Connection Charging – 1st April 2010

On 17 June 2010, NGG submitted the updated Statement and Methodology for Gas Transmission Connection Charging (the Statement) to the Authority pursuant to paragraphs 3, 4 and 9 of standard condition 4B of National Grid Gas's (NGG's) gas transporter licence.
