

# E1 Network Gas Supply Emergency Procedure

#### Introduction

This report concerns the annual review of the E1 Network Gas Supply Emergency Procedure (E1)

The version of the E1 subjected to review was version 11. That version of E1 was accepted by the E3 Alignment Group in Oct 2023 following substantial non-material textural changes to the existing procedure.

The review of version 11 of E1 was completed during May 2024 by the Energy Resilience Team at National Gas Transmission.

#### Review of E1 NGSE Procedure

The review of version 11 of E1 identified two areas where amendments to E1 were required. These are described in this review document.

The following changes have been made throughout the document and are therefore not individually referenced in the tables which follow:

<b>3.4</b>	<b>Public Appeal</b>	The text in this section has been amended to introduce the NEC Public Appeal Policy and the direction given to National Gas to produce a public appeal procedure to give guidance on disseminating messaging which in turn directs GDNs to produce public appeal plans to amplify messaging to their customers.
<b>Part 4</b>		
<b>4.2.6</b>	<b>Priority Customers</b>	This section has been amended to include minimise flows, a strategy giving direction to contact Category C customers prior to the delivery of the direction to cease taking gas, in order to direct them to minimise their gas use, this will require them to use only the gas required to protect against damage leading to repair or replacement costs.

<b>Glossary</b>
The glossary has been fully revised to match terms relevant to this version of the document. Terms which are no longer referenced have been removed.

## Results of E1 NGSE Procedure

The amendments to version 11 of E1 identified during the review were assessed to be comprehensive but non-material changes. These amendments shall be incorporated into version 12.0 which will be issued in June 2024.
