

Planning and Advanced Reservation of Capacity (PARCA)

NOTICE: PARCA WINDOW (26th April 2016)

UPDATE

Dear all,

National Grid published a notice to all interested industry parties following the receipt of a technically competent PARCA Application; a PARCA exit window was opened on the 26th April 2016 to enable those parties who are interested in applying for a PARCA to submit their applications during this time.

National Grid has received a further PARCA application in addition to the PARCA application that triggered the exit window within the first 20 consecutive business days of the PARCA exit window opening.

Application Summary:-

- The geographical area of the project is North East Yorkshire and Lincolnshire (Region 3 as defined in Gas Ten Year Statement).
- The indicative range of the NTS exit capacity applied for is 58,241,267 kWh/d – 71,183,770 kWh/d.
- The indicative capacity reservation date is 20th November 2016.
- The indicative capacity registration date is 1st October 2019.

The current PARCA exit window will therefore be open for 40 consecutive business days from the 26th April 2016, closing on the 22nd June 2016.
