Planning and Advanced Reservation of Capacity (PARCA)

PARCA NOTICE UPDATE: MILFORD HAVEN AGGREGATED SYSTEM ENTRY POINT (ASEP)

Dear Industry Colleague,

In accordance with the Uniform Network Code, Transportation Principal Document, Section B, we hereby publish this notice to all interested industry parties.

On 15 March 2019, we published a notice to confirm that a PARCA in respect of Milford Haven ASEP had progressed to Phase 2 PARCA Works, and that NTS Entry Capacity had been reserved as follows;

- The NTS Entry Point is Milford Haven Aggregated System Entry Point.
- The quantity of capacity reserved as Incremental Obligated Entry Capacity is 163,000,000kWh/d.
- The quantity of Firm Entry Capacity to be treated as;
 - Funded Incremental Obligated Entry Capacity is 163,000,000kWh/d.
 - Non-incremental Obligated Entry Capacity provided for by Capacity Substitution is 0 (zero) kWh/d.
- The indicative Registration Date is 01 January 2026 (twenty twenty-six).

We are now issuing this notice to confirm that the Registration Date has been amended to 01 January 2027.
