

Planning and Advanced Reservation of Capacity (PARCA)

NOTICE: OPENING OF A PARCA EXIT WINDOW

30th May 2019

Dear Industry Colleague,

In accordance with the Uniform Network Code, Section B, National Grid hereby publishes this notice to all interested industry parties that a PARCA Exit Window will be opened on **Monday, 3rd June**. The PARCA Exit Window provides an opportunity for those parties who are interested in applying for a PARCA to submit their applications during this time so that we can consider those applications alongside applications received to-date and other potential applications.

The application received to-date is as follows;

Application 1

- The geographical area of the project is London, Suffolk and the South East (Region 9 in the Gas Ten Year Statement¹). This region is South Diss, Cambridge and east of Whitwell and comprises NTS/DN exit zones EA4, 5, NT1, 2, 3, SE1, 2.
- The amount of NTS exit capacity applied for is between 69,702,966 kWh/d & 79,552,298 kWh/d.
- The indicative capacity reservation date is 30th November 2019.
- The indicative capacity registration date is 1st April 2026.

The PARCA Exit Window will be opened for a maximum of 40 consecutive business days from 3rd June 2019, closing on 26th July 2019. If no further PARCA Applications are received within 20 consecutive business days, the window will be closed on 28th June 2019.
