

## PMC survey 7,783 Pressure Control Storage Assets for Cadent

The PC&S project has come to a conclusion. It started in November 2015 and ended in October 2017.

The PC&S team have surveyed 7,783 sites, 550 above 7 bar sites and 7233 below 7 bar sites across Cadent's network.

The objective of the project was to visually inspect and survey the above ground pressure control and storage assets to ascertain the condition in order to prioritise asset investment and deliver on RIIO outputs.

Cadent also wanted an accurate and consistent records of asset configurations, control systems, manufacturers, models and sizes. Along with general access/security and compliance information.

James McCann, project supervisor says:
