Description
<p>The fourth Stakeholder Group meeting began with a welcome from the Chair, Trisha McAuley.</p> <p>The members considered three important topics of the Gas Transmission RIIO 2 business plan; ‘Gas on and off the NTS’, ‘Environment’ and ‘Responsible Demolition’. Working within a number of smaller groups representing their respective constituencies, the members discussed the positive aspects and the limitations of the engagement logs presented by National Grid. The Stakeholder Group’s challenges centred around four key themes: stakeholder engagement strategy, stakeholder segmentation, RIIO 1 context and reflecting consumer outcomes.</p> <p>In the final session, the Stakeholder Group discussed the National Grid’s January consultation and business plan development and Trisha gave an update on a number of recent meetings with Ofgem and the RIIO 2 challenge group.</p>
